Vermont Child Care Contribution Payroll Tax effective July 1, 2024	Beginning July 1, 2024, Vermont will require employers to remit a 0.44% payroll tax on wages to the Vermont Department of Taxes for deposit into the Child Care Contribution Special Fund. An out-of-state employer is required to remit and report Child Care Contribution for employee wages that require Vermont Income Tax withholding. Wages paid to an employee who physically works in Vermont, either on a job site or from their Vermont home, are subject to Child Care Contribution.	



	-SSC must set up the Company State Tax Table for all institutions reporting withholding to Vermont -Institutions must enroll existing employees in the new Child Care program on the State Tax Data page with effective date 7/1/2024 -Newly hired employees or transferring employee the system will automatically default the Tax Status field on State Tax Data to match the Plan coverage status on the Company State Tax Table

G4 Employee Self-Service	Navigation: Employee Self Service > Payroll > Taxes > G4 Employee Self Service Issue: The ESS tax page does not align with the new state tax page that Tax Update 24-B will create. Withholding allowances are no longer used in the state tax withholding calculations for Georgia, and values in the field overstate the Total Allowances. Added verbiage is required for the Additional Allowances field. Resolution: The following fields will be hidden from the page. • Withholding allowances • Total allowances RE: Withholding allowances are no longer included in the State Tax withholding calculations. Tax Update 24-B will gray out the field on the State Tax page. RE: The Total allowances field will be hidden because it will overstate allowances when an employee has a value in the Withholding Allowances field. Resolution: Verbiage will be added next to the Additional Withholding field so that it's consistent with the 2024 revised Form G4 and the State Tax page that Tax Update 24-B will update. • (GA Form G-4 line 4 + 5) will be added

State Tax Rates – Georgia and Ohio	The Georgia Department of Revenue updated the 2024 Employers Tax Guide with the following changes which are effective for wages paid on or after 01 July 2024: • The flat tax rate used is decreased from 5.49% to 5.39%. • The value of each dependent allowance is increased from \$3,000 to \$4,000
	Ohio's withholding methods were updated effective July 1, 2024 by the Ohio Department of Taxation. • The highest tax rate used decreased to 3.8%, from of 4.41%, but no other changes were made.
