<p>Direct Hire- Onboarding not Required</p>	<p>Issue: If onboarding is not required for rehires etc., a new row is added in Personal data with blank data.</p> <p>Solution: Now, once the employee is processed through direct hire and personal data is viewed, a new row will no longer be inserted.</p>

<p>ePerformance email notifications for transfers/rehires going to incorrect email address</p>	<p>Issue: Institutions reported that employees who have transferred to different institutions or that have been rehired have experienced an issue with their ePerformance notifications going to the previous institution's email address instead of their current email.</p> <p>Solution: After the release, ePerformance notifications should correctly generate emails based on the employee's active/primary job.</p> <p>Note: For the population of employees who have multiple active jobs at institutions that are also currently using ePerformance, the notification for all documents will go to the email associated with their job marked Primary in Job Data.</p>

Therefore, causing downstream GL Distribution Hard Stop errors when Inactive Account/Combo Code is selected.</p> <p>Solution: Change Payroll Dist Account reference table to PS_BOR_VLDCOMBO_VW, which contains only Active Account/Combo Codes.</p> <p>Completes Model Change Request CHG00575.</p>

<p>Automated Adjustments Online Page – Enhancements</p>	<p>Navigation: Menu > Payroll for North America > Payroll Customization > Automated Adjustments</p> <p>Issue: Separate Check # field is not in a central location on the automated adjustments page.</p> <p>Solution: Move the field to a newly created section named Separate Check Option.</p> <p>Issue: Transactions with an inactive combination code can be saved; no warning message is produced.</p> <p>Solution: Create hard stop message “Account code invalid” that prevents page from being saved.</p>
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	<p>Issue: Invalid Earnings Codes can be saved for Earnings Adjustment Transactions.</p> <p>Solution: A drop-down display list of active codes will be added to the Earnings Code field. An error message will be returned for use of earnings codes not on the list.</p>
G4 State Tax – Enhancements	<p>Navigation: Employee Self-Service > Payroll Tile > Taxes > G4 Employee Self-Service</p> <p>Issue: Email confirmation of change does not exist for State Tax (G4) data updates made in Employee Self-Service.</p> <p>Solution: Create email notifications for confirmation of changes. Completes Model Change Request CHG00881</p> <p>Issue: In some scenarios, when an employee has multiple employee records in different institutions, Employee Self-Service changes to State Tax (G4) data updates the incorrect employee record.</p> <p>Solution: Enhance logic to update State Tax data for the Primary Job employment record.</p>
PDF Paycheck Advice	<p>Navigation: Employee Self-Service > Payroll Tile > Pay</p> <p>Issue: When an employee with multiple records for a Company has an automated adjustment transaction set up on the inactive employee record, the PDF paycheck advice displays job data from the inactive employee record.</p> <p>Solution: PDF paycheck advice will display job data from the Primary Job record instead of lowest employee record for the Company.</p>
Automated Adjustments – Earnings Adjustment Load Enhancement	<p>Navigation: Menu > Payroll for North America > Payroll Customization > Automated Adjustments</p> <p>Issue: There is no logic on the earnings adjustment spreadsheet load to prevent a transaction for an employee's former paygroup from loading.</p>



	<p>Solution: Enhance the Earnings Adjustment Load logic. Create a new message "Empl Record does not match Job Data" when this scenario is identified.</p>
<p>Manage SSCP Contribution – Enhancement for SSC Support Users</p>	<p>Navigation: Menu > BOR Customizations > SSCP Contributions > Manage SSP Contribution</p> <p>Issue: SSC Support Users cannot change the payment type of a contribution.</p> <p>Solution: Provide the ability to change the payment type using Correct History to SSC Support. Manual entry is still required to ensure correct Pay Sched Amt. is deducted from each paycheck.</p>
<p>BOR AYP (Academic Year Pay) Type (Contracts) Renewal Process</p>	<p>Navigation: Menu > Workforce Administration > Job Information > Contract Administration > BOR Contracts Renewal</p> <p>Issue: In some instances, the BOR AYP Type (Contracts) Renewal Process was renewing the incorrect Contract number for employees with AYP Types in two different institutions.</p> <p>Solution: The program has been modified to use the AYP Type (Contract) number from the correct AYP Type (Contract) instead of defaulting to Contract 0000001.</p>

<p>BOR_MSS_TO_ADDL_PAY Query</p>	<p>Navigation: Menu > Reporting Tools > Query > Query Manager/Query Viewer</p> <p>Issue: MSS One-time Payments do not automatically update OneUSG Connect causing a large volume of manual data entry.</p> <p>Solution: There is existing functionality to upload transactions to Additional pay. A custom query has been created to capture approved MSS One-time Payments. The columns are in the correct order for the Additional Pay Load spreadsheet, so query results can be formatted, saved as a CSV file and uploaded to Additional Pay.</p> <p>Completes Model Change Request CHG00736.</p>
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<p>Payroll Presheet Audit Report</p>	<p>Navigation: Menu > Payroll for North America > Payroll Customization > Payroll Presheet Audit Report</p> <p>Issue: The March Ad Hoc release added logic in the Payroll Presheet Audit Report to return the error message "Duplicate Job Earnings Distribution Code". This should only be returned for the current row, but the logic was looking back at historical rows as well.</p> <p>Solution: Effective dated logic was added so the message is no longer returned in error.</p>
<p>HCM to Banner Report</p>	<p>Navigation: Menu > Payroll for North America > Payroll Customization > HCM to Banner</p> <p>Issue: In some instances, the incorrect position and/or hourly rate was returned for an employee with multiple positions.</p> <p>Solution: The logic in the program was modified to no longer pull position number and hourly rate from PS_PAY_CHECK.</p>

(1500,97)</i> <i>You cannot enter a contract begin date before the employee hire date on the employment record.</i></p> <p>Solution: Corrected code in PeopleCode to correct the IF statement in the Save/Edit functionality.</p>
<p>Direct Deposit (ESS and Administrator Pages)</p>	<p>Solution: Customization was removed and delivered functionality deployed.</p> <p>Issue: The message "Paper copy of Direct Deposit wage statements will be sent to your home" is hidden by a customization in OneUSG Connect as this is not an option available to</p>

PeopleSoft delivered functionality so this customization can be removed.</p> <p>Solution: Customization was removed and delivered functionality deployed.</p> <p>Navigation: Menu > Payroll for North America > Employee Pay Data USA > Create Direct Deposit</p> <p>Issue: Masking Direct Deposit Account Numbers for Administrator Direct Deposit Pages is a customization in OneUSG Connect. PeopleSoft delivered functionality so this customization can be removed.</p> <p>Solution: Customization was removed and delivered functionality deployed.</p>
<p>Employee State Tax Data Page – Iowa</p>	<p>Navigation: Menu > Payroll for North America > Employee Pay Data USA > Tax Information > Update Employee Tax Data</p> <p>Tax update 24-B delivers product modifications to support the new 2024 Iowa withholding tax calculation and brings in the following changes to the employee State Tax Data page.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Greys-out the Withholding Allowances, Withholding Percentage, and Additional Allowances fields since they are no longer used in the Iowa withholding tax calculation. 2. Adds a new label "Form IA W-4 line 7" to the Additional Amount field. 3. Adds a new field "Total Allowances" with a new label "Form IA W-4 line 6". 4. When a Tax Data record for Iowa is created with an Effective Date of 1/02/2024 or later, a default value of \$40 will appear in the Total Allowances field. 5. Allows \$0 as a valid value for Total Allowances, as specified by the Iowa Form IA W-4 instructions.
