| Purpose | To identify when key rollup trees should be copied. To identify the purpose of the new effective dating policy relating to ChartField values and trees. To copy a tree definition. |

| Description | At the end of the fiscal year, users copy key rollup trees from the previous fiscal year's tree and give an effective date of the first day of the new fiscal year (July 1). The system or the user adds any new ChartField values utilizing the same date. The purpose for the new effective dating policy is so that the University System of Georgia can maintain a historical view of ChartField values and balances while minimizing the amount of maintenance. |

Procedure

Below are step by step instructions on how to copy a tree with a new effective date.

| Step | Action |
|------|---|
| 1. | Click the NavBar icon. |
| 2. | Click the Menu icon. |
| 3. | Click the Tree Manager link. |
| 4. | Click the Tree Utilities link. |
| 5. | Click the Copy/Delete Trees link. The system navigates to the Tree Maintenance page. |
| 6. | Locate the tree and effective date combination to copy. |
| 7. | Click the Select checkbox next to the tree and effective date combination to copy. |
| 8. | Click the Copy button. The system generates the Copy Tree popup window. |
| 9. | Enter new effective date in the Effective Date field. |
| 10. | Click the Copy button. The system navigates back to the Tree Maintenance page. |
| 11. | If the tree added successfully, it displays in the grid with the new effective date. |
