<b>Purpose</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To search for the delivered security queries.</li> <li>• To run a delivered User ID query that provides a User IDs Roles, Permission Lists, and Page Access.</li> </ul>
<b>Description</b>	<p>This topic demonstrates how to search for and run delivered security queries.</p> <p>PeopleSoft delivers several security queries which can be found under Common Queries or under the User Profiles, Permissions, and Roles navigation.</p>

### Procedure

Below instructions on how to search for and view delivered securities queries.

For this topic, imagine that you need to search for and run a delivered User ID security query.

Step	Action
1.	Click the <b>NavBar</b> icon.
2.	Click the <b>Menu</b> icon.
3.	Click the <b>vertical</b> scrollbar.
4.	Click the <b>PeopleTools</b> link.
5.	Click the <b>Security</b> link.
6.	Security Queries Can either be selected from Common Queries, or they can be found under User Profiles, Permissions, or Roles. Click the <b>Common Queries</b> link.
7.	Depending on your search criteria, choose from one of the below. In the example, we will choose a query based on User ID. Click the <b>User ID Queries</b> link.
8.	Click the <b>User ID's Roles, Permission Lists, and Page Access</b> link.
9.	For example, enter " <b>AYOUNG</b> " in the <b>User ID</b> field.
10.	Click the <b>View Results</b> button.
11.	Review the results.
