

## SC.080.130 - Searching and Viewing Security Permission Lists

<b>Purpose</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To search for Permission Lists</li> <li>• To review the menus attached to a Permission List.</li> </ul>
<b>Description</b>	<p>This topic demonstrates how to search for and view security Permission Lists. A Permission List may contain any number of the following permissions, including sign-on times, page permissions, component interface permissions, and so on. A Permission List may contain one or more permissions.</p> <p>A role may contain numerous permissions and a user profile may have numerous roles assigned to it. Because permission lists are applied to users through roles, a user inherits all the permissions assigned to each role to which the user belongs. The user's access is determined by the combination of all of the roles.</p> <p>BOR permission lists will start with the two letter prefix for the module. Delivered security queries can be run by clicking on the Permission List Queries tab.</p>

### Procedure

Below are step by step instructions on how to search for and view Security Permission Lists.

For this topic, imagine that you need to view the menu items attached to the AM\_INVEN\_ASSETS\_RPT Permission List.

Step	Action
1.	Click the <b>NavBar</b> icon.
2.	Click the <b>Menu</b> icon.
3.	Click the <b>PeopleTools</b> link.
4.	Click the <b>Security</b> link.
5.	Click the <b>Permissions &amp; Roles</b> link.
6.	Click the <b>Permission Lists</b> link.
7.	Enter " <b>AM</b> " in the <b>begins with</b> field.
8.	Click the <b>Search</b> button.
9.	The BOR permission lists will start with the two letter prefix for the module. For Example, Asset Management Permission lists will start with AM, Budget Prep (BP), Accounts Payable (AP), etc.  Click an entry in the <b>Permission List</b> column.
10.	Click the <b>Pages</b> tab.
11.	This Page shows the menus attached to the permission list.
12.	Click the <b>horizontal</b> scrollbar.
13.	Click the <b>Permission List Queries</b> link.
14.	All delivered security queries can be run by clicking on the Permission List Queries tab.
