


Known Issue: KI9.2-174_Other–Issue with “Notify” Button Functionality

NAVIGATION: “Notify” Button – Multiple Navigations Exist

ISSUE: Following Release 6.00, an Oracle bug exists that affects the "Notify" button, which is present on many pages across the system. The button is not functioning on any of these pages and displays the message: "You are not authorized for this page." Here is an example of a page where the notify button is utilized, along with the display of the corresponding error message.

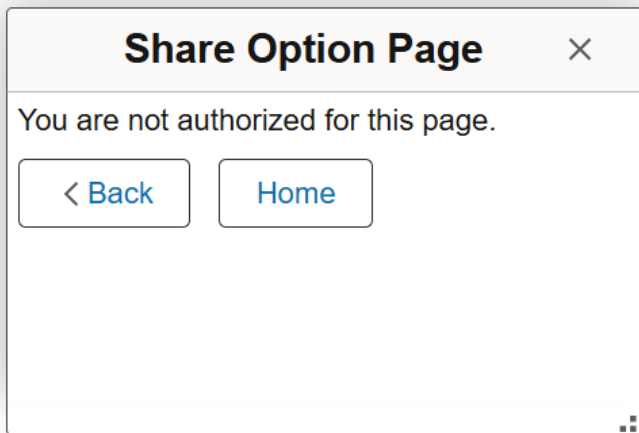
